






There are two drastically different explanations of the history of this set of 12 stamps. The first is that they were officially approved by the Spanish Andorran authorities, but not put on sale to avoid upsetting the French. The second is that they were prepared by a Spanish stamp dealer who hoped to produce tete-beche and other "errors" from his own printing plates, but the stamps were not approved by the authorities. The set is listed in the Edfil Spanish catalog.




























